

WATER TREATMENT SYSTEM UPDATE
AUGUST 21, 2023

We have been having a great deal of difficulty with our water treatment system and as a result have been relying on trucked-in water exclusively since the beginning of July. This is why you will have noticed so many water deliveries and we are grateful that we have been able to obtain a steady supply of trucked-in water given the current high demand.

In a nutshell, the situation is that we asked our plant manager to order a new UV treatment system in January since the one we have is aged out. We were not able to replace our specific existing UV system (it is no longer made) and the alternative new system ordered for us was discovered to be incapable of functioning in our situation -- so a different alternative has had to be ordered. We are told that it will be here in roughly 10 business days, and in the meantime we are obtaining the required permit from Alberta Environment (which regulates and monitors water treatment systems) so that it can be installed promptly.

Continued water conservation steps by owners are therefore still very necessary and we will send out another notice as soon as our treatment plant manager is able to get the plant up and running again.
